


Notes

About this analysis

- Using data sourced from STR, movements in hotel average daily rates (ADRs) since 2019 have been calculated for 26 European countries, including Turkey.
- For each month in 2022, ADR inflation has been calculated against the rate prevailing in the same month in 2019.
- The calculations have been based on ADRs in local currency, with the exception of Turkey, where euro-based rates have been used.
- Croatia adopted the euro in January 2023. Historic rates, originally priced in Croatian kuna, have been converted to euros for continuity purposes.





















































